Special Rules

Depot Area:

- Only individuals who have received occupational safety training may enter the depot area.
- All instructions given by personnel designated for supervision by BKV Zrt. must be followed without exception during the depot visit.
- Special attention must be paid to pedestrian and vehicular traffic as well as the risk of electric shock (825V). Entry to restricted areas is prohibited. Particular care must be taken near the tracks in the storage depot due to the risk of falling and electric shock; movement is only allowed in designated areas.
- In the buildings, especially on stairways, caution is required.
- Movement between buildings is only permitted in pedestrian-designated areas.
- Smoking is allowed only in designated areas; smoking is prohibited in all other areas.

Metro Station Areas:

- Due to the specific design of metro stations (high ceilings), there is an increased risk of falling. It is strictly forbidden to step over or lean on escalator handrails.
- Special attention must be paid to the risk of falling and electric shock, and entry to the safety zone is prohibited.
- Entry into the metro tunnel is strictly forbidden.
- All instructions given by personnel designated for supervision by BKV Zrt. must be followed without exception during the station visit.
- Smoking is prohibited in metro station areas.

In case of any issues, the designated BKV Zrt. personnel must be notified.
